As an experienced RN, you will provide care to vulnerable individuals at end of life with compassion, demonstrating an ability to respond to the needs of clients with varied clinical conditions and diagnoses. You are accustomed to helping families navigate the death of a loved one with empathy and an understanding that caring for the family is central to excellent palliation. You have strong communication skills, are used to working on an interdisciplinary team and comfortable working within a team that includes a strong core of volunteers.

- Contribute to a holistic supportive environment to meet the diverse needs of clients and families
- Develop and create individualized, holistic care plans consistent with the domains of palliative care
